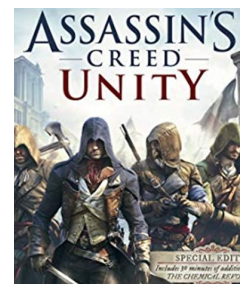

U = Universal - Suitable for all ages to watch

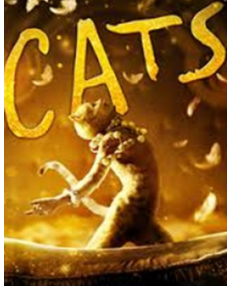
PG = Parental Guidance—Watch with a parent or guardian.

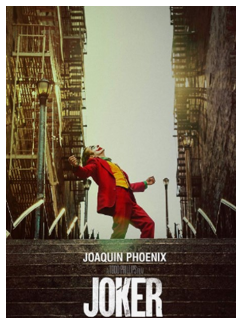

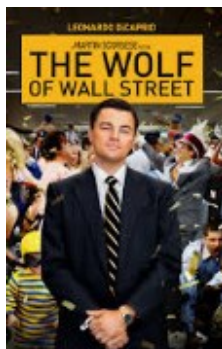

To change privacy and safety settings for yourself

1. Go to Xbox.com and sign in to your account (this must be an adult account).
2. Select your gamertag.
3. Select **Xbox settings**. If you don't see this option, select **More links** and then select **Xbox settings**.
4. Select **Privacy & online safety**.
5. Select either the **Xbox One/Windows 10 Online Safety** tab or the **Privacy** tab. Review the current settings and update any that you want to change.
6. Select **Save** before leaving or switching to another tab. If you don't save the changes before you move to the other tab, your changes won't be saved.

To change privacy and safety settings for a child

1. Go to Xbox.com and sign in to your account (this must be an adult account).
2. Select the gamertag for your child's account.
3. Select **Xbox settings**. If you don't see this option, select **More links** and then select **Xbox settings**.
4. Select **Privacy & online safety**.
5. Select either the **Xbox One/Windows 10 Online Safety** tab or the **Privacy** tab. Review the current settings and update any that you want to change.
6. Select **Save** before leaving or switching to another tab. If you don't save the changes before you move to the other tab, your changes won't be saved.
7. Have your child sign in and then sign out of their account to make sure the changes take effect.

3. Choose who you want to allow from the drop-down menu: Friends, Friends of Friends or No One and select [Confirm].
