History—Ancient Egypt: How did beliefs influence life in Ancient Egypt?

- Children will describe how Ancient Egyptians built the pyramids and explain how they were used.
- Children will investigate how Pharaohs ruled Ancient Egypt
- They will explore the role Tutankhamun had in Ancient Egypt



Geography — Was the river Nile a purposeful water source?

- Children will identify and describe the parts of a river
- They will explore how the river Nile was used by the Ancient Egyptians
- Children will use atlases to identify rivers across different continents




Writing

- Children will write their own diary—A day in the life of Howard Carter Independent write (recount). Mummify a Pharaoh.
- Children will write their own disaster story to go with the picture story The Flood.



Reading

- Flat Stanley and the Great Egyptian Robbery
- The Flood
- Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.
- Children will answer a range of reading questions based on these texts.



Maths

- Multiplication and division—children will multiply and divide 2 digit and 1 digit numbers
- Length and perimeter - measuring in cm and mm, finding equivalent lengths and adding and subtracting lengths.
- Fractions - exploring unit and non-unit fractions. Understand and finding the whole and counting fractions.

Phonics



Catch up intervention for specific children.

Light and shadows



- Children will explore sources of light, reflection and shadows.

Art




- Children explore ancient Egyptian art and use this as inspiration for their own designs.
- They will design and draw their own Ancient Egyptian headdress

Computing



- The children focus on using Desktop Publishing software
- The children will use shapes and lines to create their own poster

DT



- Children will be creating their own healthy salad and side salad linked to seasonal foods in the UK.

Music




- The children continue to learn the violins They will learn how to play more complex rhythms and rhymes. They are increasing their knowledge of musical notation (Crotchets and quavers),
