
To discover more:




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What Step On and Goldilocks words will I use?

Spelling	Definition
Ariel photograph	A photo taken from high up in the sky.
Ariel view	Seeing something from above, like looking down from a plane.
Country	A big area of land with its own people and rules.
Distance	How far one thing is from another.
Features	Important things you can see in a place, like rivers, trees, or buildings.
Globe	A round ball that shows the Earth.
Improve	To make something better.
Key	A picture that shows what the symbols on a map mean.
Land	The ground we walk on, not water.
Locate	To find where something is.
Location	A place where something is.
Map	A drawing that shows places like towns, rivers and roads.
Place	Anywhere you can go or be, like school or home.




