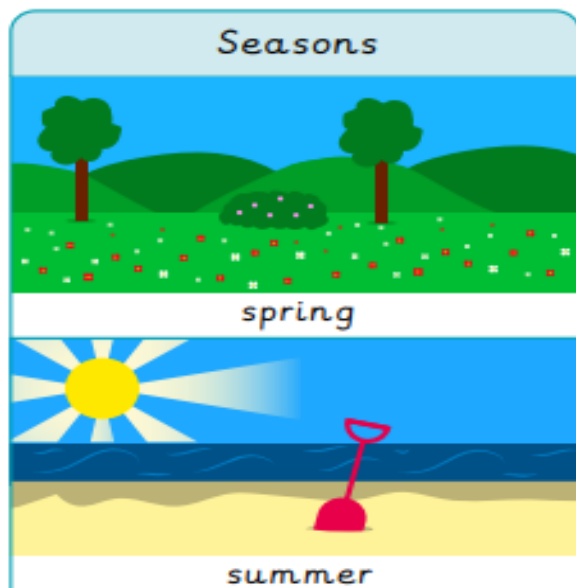

Spelling	Definition
Atlas	A book of maps
Capital city	The most important city in a country, where the leaders work.
Sea	A big area of salty water, smaller than an ocean.
Ocean	A very big area of salty water that covers much of the Earth.
Continent	A big piece of land with many countries on it, like Europe or Africa.
North Pole	The very top of the Earth, where it's icy and cold
UK	The United Kingdom; the country we live in. It is made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
Key	A picture that shows what the symbols on a map mean.
Land	The ground we walk on, not water.
Locate	To find where something is.
Location	A place where something is.
Map	A drawing that shows places like towns, rivers and roads.
Place	Anywhere you can go or be, like a park, school or home.

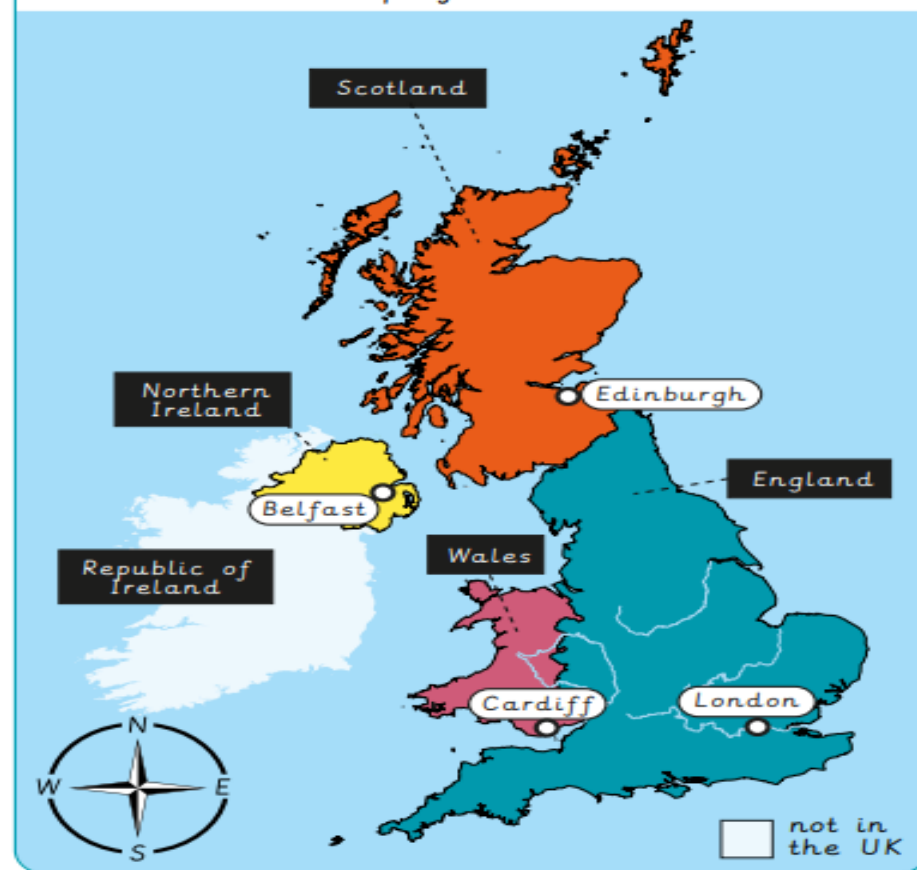
Key facts and locations

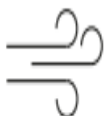

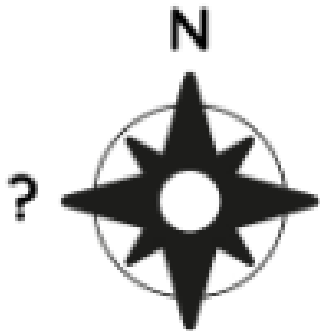
