



Uniform Policy

Adopted by Governors September 22

In 2021, a new law was passed to make school uniforms affordable. Statutory guidance was published by the DFE.

Our policy is simple, a non-nonsense approach for easy access to purchasing and affordability. We believe school uniform should not place a financial burden on families and be easily purchased from all major Supermarkets/stores. We only ask that a School Sweatshirt/Cardigan with the School Logo be purchased, which is available from:

- CC Uniforms, Kings Square, West Bromwich
- Oakes, Rood End, Oldbury

By encouraging school uniform it can play a key role in:

- promoting the ethos of a school
- remove any barriers from branded clothing/stimulus
- providing a sense of belonging and identity
- setting an appropriate tone for education

School Uniform

White/pale blue shirt or Polo Shirt

Grey Trousers/Skirt or Pinafore

Grey Shorts or Gingham Dress for Summer

Sensible Shoes – no high heels/platforms

PE Kit

White T-shirt or Polo shirt

Black shorts or Jog bottoms

Black pumps for indoors and Trainers for Outdoors

Head garments worn for religious purposes should be Black, White or Blue.

Swimming

Towel & Swim Cap required for all (regulation set by Swimming Centres)

Swim Shorts

One-piece costume for girls (no bikinis)

Earrings- studs only which should be removed for PE lessons and Swimming. No other jewellery other than a wristwatch, items of religious significance may be worn for school following agreement with Senior Management.
